ENTRY INFORMATION

A. Entries close at 12 pm, September 2, 2009. Fees must accompany entries. The Club and/ or its Match Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by owner or agent of the owner. The Club and its Match Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.

B. Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

C. Declination of entries. The participating Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

D. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

JUDGING

The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Unentered dogs are not allowed in the show area.

TROPHIES

Trophy will be given to individual handling dog in the ring. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Gateway Yorkshire Terrier Club, assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor, agent, spectator, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for children. The welfare of the child of an exhibitor or as a spectator is assumed to be the responsibility of that person. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors or spectators will use control and restraint over their children at this show.

GROOMING AND CRATING

The Show Committee anticipates limited crating & grooming room. The Club requires that crates be stacked & reserves the right to allocate grooming space for the convenience of all. All space is available on a first-come-first-served basis.

Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for the clean conditions in and around their grooming area. **No dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.**

EXERCISING DOGS

The Club wishes to maintain a good reputation with the show site management. There will be designated exercise areas and all exhibitors are expected to comply with the exercise area signs.

CATALOGS

All catalogs will be sold. None will be given away.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON US ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN US FUNDS.

NO BABY STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED RINGSIDE.

If dogs are left in unattended closed vehicles, the owner will be paged. If there is no immediate response to this page, vehicle windows may be broken! All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Gateway Yorkshire Terrier Club or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
